No. of weeks: 5</p> <p>SPECIAL EVENTS Write Yourself In: Scriptwriting session</p>	<p>Mathematics</p> <p>Children will be learning to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> identify 3d shapes, including cubes and other cuboids, from 2d representations. know angles are measured in degrees: estimate and compare acute, obtuse and reflex angles. draw given angles, and measure them in degrees (°). identify angles at a point and one whole turn (total 360°); angles at a point on a straight line and $\frac{1}{2}$ a turn (total 180°); other multiples of 90°. use the properties of rectangles to deduce related facts and find missing lengths and angles. distinguish between regular and irregular polygons based on reasoning about equal sides and angles. identify, describe and represent the position of a shape following a reflection or translation, using the appropriate language, and know that the shape has not changed.
<p>This half term, we will be using Greek Myths as the focus of our learning in English. We will explore character development in narrative and learn how to describe character's actions and reactions to the plot effectively. As part of this, we will write a new chapter for a story which incorporates links to previous events and builds on key themes. In terms of grammar, we will develop our understanding of varying our sentence lengths using relative and embedded clauses, particularly in thinking how to build suspense for the reader. We will continue to develop our paragraphing skills when writing to signal shifts in mood, atmosphere or time as well. Our spelling learning for this half term will be focused on revising key rules and strategies for spelling words at the expected level for Year 5.</p>
