

**Consultation for Asfordby Captain's Close Primary School's Training Swimming Pool**

**21.10.21**

Dear members of the community & stakeholders,

I am writing to you to inform you of our decision to commence a period of public consultation to seek community ideas and possible alternative funding solutions for the training swimming pool at Captain's Close Primary School, Asfordby.

We have undertaken a detailed review of the training pool in relation to its educational benefit, running costs, capital investment needed and its overall ongoing management. Swim England UK have undertaken a condition report which highlights the need for significant investment. We have engaged with local community users who use the training pool on alternative ways to raise funds to improve the training pool and tried to explore external grant funding also.

**We would like to hear and explore any ideas from the community and stakeholders which we may have not considered.** I enclose a copy of our consultation pack for your information.

The consultation period is running for six weeks starting Thursday 21<sup>th</sup> October until Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> December 2021.
